The SafetyCheck review examines how a program compares to industry norms and makes recommendations, where appropriate, as to how a program can develop strengths and work towards improving areas creating risk management challenges.

THE SAFETYCHECK PROCESS

The SafetyCheck process begins with a self assessment questionnaire and follow-up interview. The questionnaire has been developed to broadly survey your organizations activities. A follow up site visit by one of our highly experienced advisers will look at current practices, site safety and general risk management considerations. The purpose of the on-site review is to address any specific areas identified in the self assessment and for the adviser to see first hand how programs operate. The review culminates with a program report and debriefing. The adviser will go over the report with you looking at the highlighted strengths, identified areas to work on and discuss the specific recommendations.

SAFETYCHECK LEVELS

Direct Bearing's SafetyCheck program has been developed to accommodate a range of needs. We offer two levels of external review (Basic and Comprehensive) and an integrated partnership program that gives your organization access to our collection of risk management resources, ongoing support from our professional staff, annual training workshops and scheduled SafetyCheck reviews.
