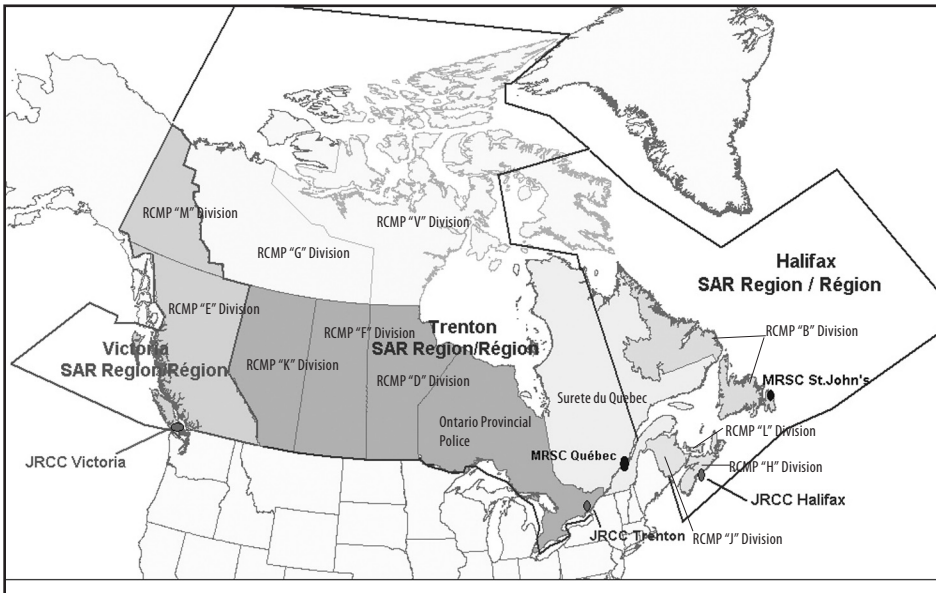
The Direct Bearing Network represents a group of people responsible for risk management in their organizations.

# The Canadian Search and Rescue System



## MARITIME SAR

Areas covered by the Maritime SAR system are navigable waterways under federal jurisdiction including all coastal regions, the Great Lakes and St. Lawrence River waterways. Operational responsibility for these regions are carried out by the Canadian Coast Guard and the Canadian Forces. Maritime SAR response is conducted under five regions. Contact your nearest Rescue Centre at the numbers below in the event of an emergency in the Maritime SAR coverage area.

## GROUND SAR

Ground SAR covers all land and in-land waterways not under federal jurisdiction (except for National Parks). Operational response falls under provincial and territorial police authority. The RCMP covers most regions in Canada except Ontario, Quebec, some areas in Newfoundland & Labrador and National Park lands. Calling 9-1-1 will put you in touch with the local police or parks service. When 9-1-1 is not available or you're calling from a satellite phone call the nearest local detachment of the police or parks service responsible for SAR in the area. The following numbers are the provincial level or national level (National Parks) contacts that will be able to provide local or regional emergency numbers for the areas you're planning to travel.
